**CALL TO ORDER**

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

Dr. Kleitsch presented the agenda for approval. Dr. Souheaver moved to approve the agenda. Dr. Fuendeling seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

**New Business**

2010-2011 Licensure Renewals:

Dr. Souheaver moved to approve the following determination:

**Emergency Rule adopted July 1, 2010**

The Arkansas Psychology Board finds that due to circumstances regarding completion of the licensure renewal process, there is imminent peril to the public health, safety, or welfare that requires adoption of a rule upon less than thirty (30) days' notice. Renewal of licenses has been hampered by technical, environmental and health issues and all timely submitted renewals may not have been processed by July 1, 2010. To ensure continued services to the public, the Board determines that all currently licensed persons for whom application and renewal fee have been received by the Board office or are postmarked as of June 30, 2010 will have their license renewed effective July 1, 2010. Applications post-marked on or before June 30, 2010, but determined to be incomplete, will

not be subject to late fees. All license renewal applications received and post-marked after June 30, 2010 will be subject to the current rule regarding late renewal (as shown below) unless extenuating circumstances can be shown and subject to the approval of the Board.

#### **14.4. Penalty/Reinstatement.**

Failure to apply for and pay the license renewal fee by July 1 shall result in suspension of the license as long as the application and fee are delinquent. Reinstatement of suspended license shall automatically occur at the time the registration fee plus the delinquent renewal fee (Section 13.7) are paid.

Ms. Glenn seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

#### **Adjourn**

Ms. Glenn moved to adjourn at 8:45. Dr. Souheaver seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. The Board adjourned at 8:45AM.
